Moordale (100gm)

NEEDLES

1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

TENSION

23 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 4 mm (US 6) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed wrap is 51.5 cm (20% in) wide and approx 172 cm (67% in) long.

NEEDLES

Set of 5 double-pointed 3½mm (no 10) (US 3) needles Set of 5 double-pointed 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

TENSION

26 sts and 27 rounds to 10 cm measured over patterned st st, 23 sts and 30 rounds to 10 cm measured over st st, both using 4mm (US 6) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed mittens are 21.5 cm (8½ in) in circumference and 30 cm (11¾ in) long.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

M1L = make one stitch by picking up horizontal loop before next stitch from front and knitting into back of it;
M1R = make one stitch by using left needle and picking up horizontal loop before next stitch from behind and knitting into front of it.

TENSION

26 sts and 27 rounds to 10 cm measured over patterned st st, 23 sts and 30 rounds to 10 cm measured over st st, both using 4mm (US 6) needles.

TENSION

 $22~\rm sts$ and $38~\rm rows$ to $10~\rm cm$ measured over g st using 4mm (US 6) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

When laid flat as a square, completed wrap meas approx 114 cm (45 in) across.


4mm (no 8) (US 6) circular needle no more than 40 cm long **OR** set of 4 double-pointed 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

TENSION

26 sts and 27 rounds to 10 cm measured over patterned st st using 4mm (US 6) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed scarf is 24.5 cm (9¾ in) wide and approx 202 cm (79½ in) long.

NEEDLES

Set of 5 double-pointed 3½mm (no 10/9) (US 4) needles Set of 5 double-pointed 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

TENSION

25 sts and 27 rounds to 10 cm measured over patt using 4mm (US 6) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed mittens are 19 cm ($7\frac{1}{2}$ in) in circumference around palm and 26.5 cm ($10\frac{1}{2}$ in) long.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

M1L = make one stitch by picking up horizontal loop before next stitch from front and knitting into back of it;
M1R = make one stitch by using left needle and picking up horizontal loop before next stitch from behind and knitting into front of it.

TENSION

 $25~\rm sts$ and $27~\rm rounds$ to $10~\rm cm$ measured over patt using 4mm (US 6) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed beret is 88~cm (34% in) in circumference and 28~cm (11~in) in diameter.

4mm (no 8) (US 6) circular needle no more than 60 cm long


TENSION

24 sts and 30 rounds to 10 cm measured over patt (when slightly stretched) using 4mm (US 6) circular needle.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed cowl is 77.5 cm ($30\frac{1}{2}$ in) in circumference and 21.5 cm ($8\frac{1}{2}$ in) deep.

A Sloe 017 1

B Feather 001 1

NEEDLES

3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) circular needle no more than

40 cm long

 $4\mathrm{mm}$ (no 8) (US 6) circular needle no more than

40 cm long

TENSION

26 sts and 27 rounds to 10 cm measured over patterned st st using 4mm (US 6) circular needle.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed cowl is $61.5 \text{ cm} (24\frac{1}{4} \text{ in})$ in circumference and approx $24.5 \text{ cm} (9\frac{3}{4} \text{ in})$ deep.

COWL

Using 3½mm (US 3) circular needle and yarn A cast on 160 sts. Work in rounds as folls:

Round 1 (RS): *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

This round forms rib.

Cont in rib until work meas 2 cm.

Change to 4mm (US 6) circular needle.

Beg and ending rounds as indicated, using the **fairisle** technique as described on the information page and repeating the 16 st patt repeat 10 times around each round, cont in patt from chart, which is worked entirely in st st (K every round), as folls:

Rep the 16 round patt repeat 3 times, then work rounds 1 to 8 again. 56 chart rounds in total.

(Cowl should meas approx 22.5 cm from cast-on edge.)

Break off yarn B and cont in yarn A only.

Change to 34mm (US 3) circular needle.

Now work in rib as given for cast-on edge for 2 cm. Cast off in rib.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

NEEDLES

Set of 4 double-pointed 3½mm (no 10/9) (US 4) needles Set of 4 double-pointed 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

TENSION

24 sts and 30 rounds to 10 cm measured over patt (when slightly stretched) using 4mm (US 6) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed hat is 53.5 cm (21 in) in circumference and 20.5 cm (8 in) deep with brim folded over.

YARN

Moordale (100gm)

A Feather 001 2 B Turmeric 003 1 C Blue Moor 008 1

NEEDLES

1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles 1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles 4mm (no 8) (US 6) circular needle at least 80 cm long

EXTRAS – 55 cm length of 3 cm (1¼ in) wide elastic (optional)

TENSION

 $27~\rm sts$ and $62~\rm rows$ to $10~\rm cm$ measured over patt using 4mm (US 6) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Excluding gusset, completed bag is 36 cm (14½ in) wide and 42.5 cm (16¾ in) high. Gusset is 5 cm (2 in) wide.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

wyab = with yarn at back (WS) of work; wyaf = with
yarn at front (RS) of work.
